Larry was born in 1951 and has been a lifelong resident of the Town of Gerry. Larry graduated from Cassadaga Valley Central School and has been involved in many different activities/organizations after his graduation. He was a drummer in a local band, was the owner of Gay-Mark Tire & Wheel, was elected Chautauqua County legislator and subsequently was elected as Chautauqua County Clerk, a position he still holds.

Larry is a Cassadaga Valley history buff and joined the Valley Historical Society in 1991. In 1993 he became president of the organization, serving in that capacity for more than 20 years. Larry has been the driving force behind the Sinclairville History Fair which will celebrate its 25th anniversary this year on September 14th, 2024. He wrote a book about the history of the area titled "Sinclairville, The Lost History" and it can be found in our local library. Larry also often shares historical tidbits of the area on the History of Sinclairville and Surrounding Areas Facebook page.

In his capacities as a politician, and President of the Historical Society, Larry has been very diligent in keeping municipalities in the Cassadaga Valley region well informed and up to date with current happenings relative to the area.

Larry lives with his wife Carol in Gerry and continues to be very active in the community.

WATER PROJECT UPDATE

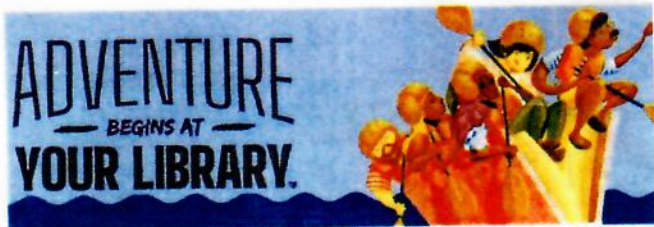
Now that the Village of Sinclairville's Water Project has been completed and is working efficiently, The Village is working with a company named Verisk Inc., a division of the Insurance Service Office, to conduct water flow testing on our fire hydrants throughout the Village. Once the testing has been completed, Verisk and the Insurance Service Office will share the results with fire insurance companies in New York. The Insurance companies will then use this information to set their rates for fire insurance for the residences of Sinclairville.



The last time this testing was done was in 2005 when we were using the old water system. Verisk and the Insurance Service Office are confident that our flow rating will much improve with the new water system and this in turn should help to reduce the rates that insurance companies are charging our Village residents for fire insurance. This testing and information will also improve fire protection within our Village. There is no charge for the testing.

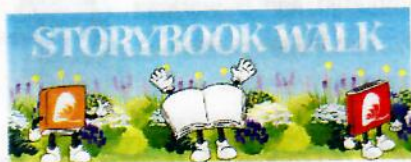

DOG LEASH LAW. Dogs are not permitted to run at large in the Village. All dogs must be confined to their own property unless on a leash. Please do not let your dogs run unleashed at the Village Parks

OPEN BURNING Prohibited State-Wide! Small campfires are allowed.

NEVER LEAVE A BURNING FIRE UNATTENDED

BUILDING PERMITS Building permits are required in the Village. Please check with the Building Code Officer, Toby Hammond 716 664-1676 **BEFORE** you start your project.

CURFEW: All individuals under the age of 18, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian, **MUST** be off the Village Streets from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

RUBBISH AND GARBAGE: Garbage or rubbish can not be stored or accumulated on any premises in the Village. Exterior property must be kept free from conditions which could create health or safety hazards or fire. This includes keeping your lawns mowed and free of debris.
