- The Sinclairville Library Association was founded on February 4, 1870 by Rev. Elbridge P.McElroy of the Congregational Church by the donation of his private library of 185 volumes and \$25 dollars for that purpose. Although the library is the oldest one in Chautauqua County, it has only had a permanent home at 15 Main Street since 2000. Prior to construction of the library building, the library had moved 14 times since 1894. In 2025, we will celebrate the 25 th anniversary of our library's building and the community that worked together to give their library a permanent home. Please join us on September 13 to help us celebrate and commemorate this glorious occasion. We will remember the past as we celebrate the future of this grand building. The library's purpose continues to be as Rev. McElroy intended: "To encourage the youth of Sinclairville and vicinity to form good habits and a taste for reading, and to promote the mental improvement of all in said place."
